Toll booth #2. This is the last one.



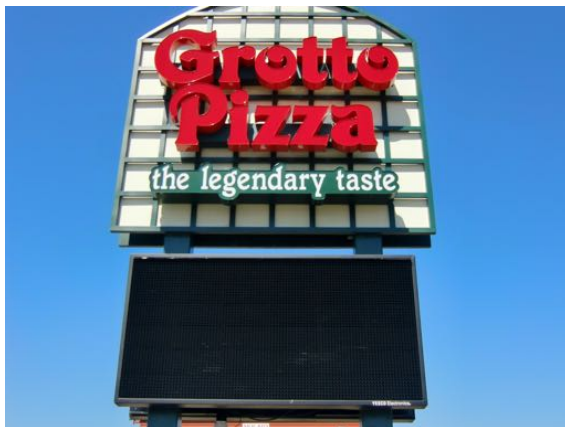
Odometer: 111.9
